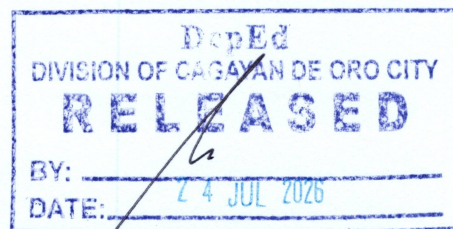

In consonance to DepEd order number 76, s. 2012 re: Revitalizing Scouting Movement in schools nationwide, and as per Division Memorandum number 465 series of 2023, the field is hereby informed of the **Patrol Leaders Training Course (PLTC) and Crew Leaders Training Course (CLTC) (Private and Public Institution) on August 21-23, 2026, at Mambuaya National High School, Barangay Mambuaya, Cagayan de Oro City.**
